I noticed that there were some people looking out of the windows, but did not note any other activity.

We made the left had turn onto Elm Street and were proceeding in the direction of the underpass chroute to Standons Freewy. A motorcycle pulled up alongside of the car and Chief Curry yelled "Is applody hurt?", to wich the officer replied in the affirm tive, and Chief Curry chiefely broadcast to surround the building. By that time we had gotte, just the lookief Curry's car had started to pick up speed, and someone yelled to get to the nearest hospital, and Chief Curry proadcast for the hospital to be ready. We then proceeded as fast as possible to the hospital and as soon as the President, Vice President, and Governor Commally were inside the hospital I immediately left in a police car for the Texas Schoolbook Depository Building.
