## AT VULSA, OKLAHOMA

JOHN G. MONAHAN, 1010 East 36th Place, who is Secretary and Assistant Treasurer of the "Oil and Gas Journal" magazine in Tulsa, on December 2, 1963, advised SA CLAIR B. IMPEY that ROLLAND C. CARPENTER, who formerly was employed by the "Oil and Cas Journal" magazine, is now General Manager of "Petroleum Engineers," a magazine publication at Dullas, Texas.

MCRAMAN stated that CARPENTER informed him to normally extra lunch at a restaurant across the street from his office building. According to CARPEWIER, the proprietor of this restaurant had informed him that JACK RUSY and LEE MARVEY OSWALD had been in his restaurant together on two or three occusions.

MONAMAN was unable to furnish the name or address of the restaurant, but stated he had learned from CARPENTER that the owner of the restaurant is of Greek descent. and is sa elderly man who did not want to get involved in any inquiries.

MUMANAN stated be further learned the restaurant was located approximately three to four blocks from JACK BUBY's might club in Dallas.

Mr. ROLAND C. CARPENTER, General Manager, Petroleum Engineers, Incorporated, 800 Davis Building, advised that on Tuesday, November 26, 1963, he was having lunch at the Eatwell Care on Main Street and he was ongaged in a conversation with JIMMY (Last Name Unknown), owner of the cafe. He stated that he and JIMM discussed the assassination of the President and the killing of LEE HARVEY OSVALD by JACK RUBY.

CARPENTER advised that JIMM was an elderly man and has recently had several strokes. He stated that JIMMY was quite upset over the assassination of the Fresident.

CARPENTER stated that Will montioned to him that JACK RUBY had been in the restaurant several times to eat, but did not furnish any further decails. CARPENIER stated that they had discussed the possibility that OSMALD and RJBY had known each other prior to the assassination. he stated that JIMMY did not wish to discuss the matter any surther because he did not want to get involved.

CARPENTER advised that he has never seen RUBY or OSWALD in the Eatwell Cafe. CARPLNTER stated that since the shooting of OS'ANLD by RUBY, there have been many rumors linking RUBY and OSWALD but he, C. RPENTER, does not hold much credence in these rumors.

Mr. JAMES GAMBULOS, 76 years of age, 3137 Bryn Mawr, advised that he is the owner of the Eatwell Restaurant, 1404 Main Street, but because of several recent strokes, has spent very little time at the restaurant. Be stated that it is being managed by his brother, San ACMBULOS.

CAMSULOS savised that he is not personally acquainted with JACK RUBY but after RUBY killed LEE RANKYK OSKALD, he had beard his brother; SAM, mention that RUBY had been in the resteurant several times in recent months to eat. GAMBULOS stated that he did not hear his orother mention that CGMALD had been in the cafe or that he had been seen in the presence or RUBY at the cafe.

GAMBULOS advised that he could furnish no further information concerning this matter.

Mr. SAM GAMBSLOS, Wineger, Debusli Rescourant, 1404 Main Street, advised that he is acquainted with JACK RDDY incourant as RDDY has easen as this restaurant numerous times prior to his being involved in the shooting of LEE MARVAY OSWALD.

CAMBULOS advised that this restaurant is open 24 lours a day and is just a chort distinct from RUSY's place of business on Commerce Street. In secred that RUSY would come in on many occasions dator his club closed in the early morning hours. He succed that he knows nothing about RUSY personally or any of his associations.

GAMBULOS advised that moither he nor his help are acquainted with OSMLID, nor had they ever son him in the restaurant at any time. CAMBULOS advised that the restaurant averages 2,500 patrons per day, and it is physically impossible to recall every patron who enters the restaurant, but advised that he has never soon anyone recembling OSWALD in the company of RUBY at the time that RUBY was in the restaurant.
