TELEPHONE CONVERSATION BETWEEN THE PRESIDENT AND  
McGEORGE BUNDY

(McGeorge Bundy to The President) ✓

LBJ: Yes, Mac.

McB: Mr. President. One of the papers...one of the tickers has it that one of the Governors says that you say that DeGualle is definitely coming sometime next year...we can make this as hard or as soft as you want...do you have a view on that?

LBJ: No...no..I told them I'd asked him to come...that he had planned ..had some tentative plans to come next year...and that I would ask him to consider doing that..

McB: Well the matter is still under discussion..don't want to...

LBJ: I don't care...although he told me he would..

McB: He said he would...probably don't want to pin him in the papers...

LBJ: No...no...no

McB: We'll say that the prospect of a visit was discussed ...as planned. O.K. That's what I need to know.

LBJ: We had a good meeting with the Governors...

McB: Oh, good. I heard them out first then I thought that was very touching...good.

LBJ: Thank you, my friend.

McB: Right, sir.
