Dear Chris,

Got your letter of the 29th. One of the men here just gave me a stamp, so now I can answer your questions.

Sorry I had to lie to you about just returning from abroad. I had to figure your phone it was tapped, so I did what I had to do.

Have been running since April 28 and everything that's happened from that date has been continued by those in the agency who want to see I dead.

My trust was deposited in the 1st State Bank of Ellijay, Ga. All \$1,700,000.00. I can not prove that, have no deposit slip. But, I called Ken (the bank president) at least every day from the day we left Ellijay. There are two banks in Ellijay; Ken Marshall is President of one of the banks, Ken - Pres. - of the other. \$181,000.00 \$50,000.00 and \$2371.00 were deposited in 1st Natl Bank of Ga, in Atlanta. Checks were written on these banks for purchases of the motor home, the VW and several other items. I understand charges are pending against me for these checks. Charges were no charges should exist. Perhaps you can check all this information out.

The journal will work its way to you. Remember, Chris, those responsible for Dallas are still alive and well and - in control! Do what you are able, just go very, very carefully. You know what they did to you in '76. You will now be asking for a bullet. I say that because I want you to know what you are getting into.

I can not tell you what further is doing, or what they have. I'd like photo stat of the story as they print it.

Dear Sheriff Stanley:

Here is the package of information on Mr. R.B. Culligan that I said I would send you in our telecon of 12 October 1978. This set of documents and tapes will give you some insight into the true nature of this situation and will-I hope- set your mind at ease regarding the dropping of the two charges pending in your jurisdiction in Ellijay.

I cannot blame you for being apprehensive regarding Mr. Culligan. All you know about him so far, are the two bad check charges and you are understandably reluctant to see them dropped. Yet the truth of this story is so far beyond the charges that you know about that it is almost beyond the scope of most peoples understanding.

I have been personally involved in the fight to get Mr. Culligan's situation amicably resolved for over two years now and I personally have no doubts regarding the truths that pertain to this story. Please take the time necessary to read the documentation I am enclosing and listen to the tapes and then, if you feel that there are reasonable grounds to believe that this story is a plausible one, I would ask that you do your best to see that these charges are dropped. I would like you to keep this information confidential as I stated on the telephone but I have no objections to your sharing it with the Justice of the Peace, the District Attorney and anyone else whom you feel has a right to know. I am also sending a similar package of data to Gene Wright as I feel he and the Cains also deserve to know what has been going on.

The items of information that I am conveying to you and the order in which I suggest you screen them is as follows:

- 1) The package of correspondence I have had with Fla. Atty. Gen. Robert Shevin concerning this situation. Read through this until you reach my letter to him dated 19 Sept. 1976. When you have read this letter, play the tape recordings that are referred to in this letter and which are included in this package.

- 2) Finish reading the packet of Bob Shevin correspondence. Please note the copy of Mr. Shevin's letter to Senator Frank Church dated 14 October 1976. You know that when a politician of Mr. Shevin's stature will make a move such as this, that he feels there must be something to this story.
- 3) When you have finished reading the Shevin correspondence, please listen to the tape I prepared for Congressman Elliot Levitas on 11 November 1977. This will give you additional insight into this situation.
- 40 Finally, read the letter I received from Mr. Culligan dated 2 Sept. 1978 and written from the county jail in Chattanooga Tennessee where he is presently located. This will give you Mr. Culligan's version of what has happened recently and will also inform you as to the situation and danger I am in at present.

If I were a man of means and had the money, I would personally post all the bonds necessary and pay off all the alleged bad checks that are supposed to have been written and secure Mr. Culligan's release so that he may make the necessary arrangements to get his journal delivered and this situation ended. Unfortunately, I am not financially in this position but I am doing what I can.

There are forces that operate within our Government that most people do not even suspect exist. In the past, these forces have instituted actions that would be repugnant to the American people and the world at large. I have always wanted to see this situation handled quietly and honorably without a lot of publicity. Unfortunately, the agencies, bureaus, and services involved are devoid of honor. This story is extremely close to going public soon and when it does, I fear for the effect upon our Country and her position in the world community.

I have much more documentation on this situation but I hope that this will be sufficient to convince you where the truth is.

Please do what you can to help us in our efforts. If there is any further information you would like to have, please contact me.

Dear Director Turner:

Enclosed find a tape of 35 minutes duration. Please listen to all of it.

From my previous contacts with you, Anthony Lapham, and others, you must realize I am trying only to acquire what is rightfully mine; recognition, retirement, the return of my trust fund and the expulsion of all criminal records now on file against me.

Listen to both sides of the recording. I am telling the truth, as determined by Psychological Stress Evaluation (PSE), examined by William Warren, The University of North Carolina and the University's experts in PSE.

To date I have held my hand, as far as exposure of any material to the media. I am determined not to be an Agee or Marchetti. Your reaction to the enclosed tape and my journal, sent you last year, (May 1977), will determine which direction I will go in the future.

Your comments, repeated in the newspapers, about Agee and others who wish to speak out against CIA, I hope will govern my relationship with you. Let us resolve our problems privately. It would satisfy me enormously to disappear into the scenery without noise, notoriety, or fan fare. I believe I've earned that satisfaction and all I am requesting.

Mr. Director, I have served this Country 35 years (28 years with CIA). Let me retire. That is all I really give a damn about.

In the event you ignore my request, this tape, or my other conditions, I am prepared to publish, print, speak out, yell, scream, to anyone who will listen. My wife and I have fought CIA and suffered for five long years, we will "let it all hang out" now if need be.

Please listen and let us - the two of us - sit down and iron out what difficulties exist. I will bring another copy of my journal (you already have one). We can reason together and no one in the world need hear or see a word of any conversation we have.


The tape is the result of efforts made in my behalf by Mr. William Warren, retired O.S.I., USAF and a friend, Mr. C. W. Farrell of Florida. Mr. Farrell has six copies of the enclosed tape placed in, at least, six locations around the United States.

Dear Mr. Prior:

I am enclosing a package of information and tape recordings pertaining to Mr. Roland B. Culligan who I believe, has four forgery charges pending against him in your jurisdiction. I am doing this so that you may become aware of the true aspects of Mr. Culligans situation. I spoke with Ms. Marie Geiser about this matter yesterday and she suggested that I forward this file to your attention.

I would appreciate it very much if you would keep this information in strictest confidence. As you get into it, you will be able to judge for yourself the enormity of this situation. I assure you that everything I am conveying to you is true and to the best of my abilities, I have checked everything out wherever possible.

It will take several hours of intense concentration to digest this information but please follow the method I have outlined in my letter to Sheriff Firman Stanley inperusing this material (copy attached). As a result of my letter to Sheriff Stanley, the charges pending in Ellijay were dropped. I am also enclosing a copy of a letter I wrote to District Attorney General Gary Gerbitz of Chattanooga, Tennessee. Charges were dropped there also.

At the time that Mr. Culligan used the credit cards in question in your jurisdiction, both he and his wife were fleeing for their lives from Central Intelligence and the use of the aforementioned credit cards were their only means of survival. Mr. Culligan's release from Chattanooga was obtained last Friday by posting a fugitive bond for your charges in Florida and he is now engaged in intense negotiations with C.I.A. to obtain what is justly his. As evidence of this last statement. I am enclosing a copy of Mr. Culligan's cover letter to DCI Stansfield Turner together with the tape recording alluded to in the letter. It might be best for you to read this letter first and play this particular tape in order that you may be quickly apprised of the situation.


This story is at first, almost unbelievable but I have spent the past 27 months of my life fighting this cause and I know it is true. At present, we are anxiously awaiting Admiral Turner's response to Mr. Culligan's letter to determine where we go from there.

It is a sad reflection on our country to think that the actions which are outlined in this data package have been allowed to occur. I can only hope that there will finally be an honorable solution to this situation and that our country can get back on course once again as it was intended to be when it was founded. Anything else is too horrible to speculate on.

I want to thank you in advance for taking the time to analyze this information and I can assure you that as soon as Mr. Culligan gets his status straightened out, that full restitution will be made. In the meantime, we are all in the deadliest of peril and have no guarantees of survival.

Dear Paul:

I felt compelled to write you this letter and just bring you up to date on a few of the things that have happened in the last two years since we talked last regarding Bud Culligan. I always believed that when you first became aware of this situation, that you had a sincere desire to help but that you received instructions from higher up to back off. For this reason and this reason only, I am sending you the enclosed package of information. I want you to know what has happened in this matter and you may share this information with whomever you wish or keep it to yourself as you see fit.

I will briefly give you a synopsis of some of the significant events that have transpired and you may judge for yourself where the truth lays in this story.

The first letter I want you to read, is a copy of one that I sent to Bud on January 17, 1977 - this will tell you just exactly how I came to lose my job with my good friend David Reid.

Bud, as you know, was released in April of 1977. Following an awful lot of maneuvering on his part attempting to get satisfaction from our "government", he was re-arrested in Orlando on phony parole violation charges. I say phony because he was charged with failing to check in with his parole office in Kansas City and yet I have in my file copies of telephone bills from a telephone number where Sara was working to the parole office - this proves that checks were made. Nevertheless, he was re-arrested and as this was a non-bondable offense, he was transferred to the Federal Prison at Atlanta. He was finally released from Atlanta in February of this year and went to Orlando, Florida where Sara was now living.

Once in Orlando, he again entered into intense negotiations with CIA to try to obtain what is rightfully his. He even filed a civil rights suit against CIA in Federal Court. We thought that everything was finally going to be resolved. He was notified that he would be recognized and allowed to retire. He went so far as to plan for his retirement ceremony at Patrick Air Force Base and sent out invitations. I am enclosing a copy of the one that my wife and I received. The tape recording, entitled "Bud's retirement" will give you some of the details leading up to this event and what happened. This was not hearsay, Pat & I were there!

Now play the tape labeled CUF & Dick Schultz dated April 30, 1978. This is a conversation Major Schultz and I had following the collapse of the retirement ceremony. You can hear for yourself just exactly how much Federal Judge Young in Orlando had been working in Bud's behalf on another incident that occurred while he was home.

After the "retirement ceremony", Bud and Sara vanished from the face of the earth. I tried everything I knew to locate him but to no avail. I did trace his progress through the country from phone bills that he charged to Major Schultz' phone number in Orlando, but I always found that he had left any given location.

This changed abruptly on August 24 of this year when I received a phone call from Mary Schultz who had just heard from Sara. Bud had just been arrested in East Ridge, Tennessee and Sara and Jody were fleeing and seeking sanctuary. I was able to track Bud down using my telephone. I spoke to him initially on August 24th and found out that he and Sara had been fleeing for their lives since April. I was able to arrange a phone call between myself, Sara and Bud by using the conference features of our telephone system. Listen well to this conversation and realize that at this time, this was the first contact Sara had with Bud since his arrest and that at the time, she had less than \$5.00 to her name and was desperately trying to find safety.

Bud had been arrested for using "stolen" credit cards. The computer program that caught him was the work of a Mr. William Warren of the First Union National Bank in Charlotte, North Carolina. Mr. Warren is in charge of the investigations department of that bank and had several talks with Bud following his arrest. Mr. Warren spent approximately 20 years in O.S.I. during and after WW2. Bud asked me to provide Mr. Warren with a file of the information I have concerning him as he felt that he could possibly help out (my file is much larger than it was when I met with you and Frank Wilson back in November of 1976). I did so and Mr. Warren became quite active in helping us get to the truth of this situation. Mr. Warren is an expert in the use of the Psychological Stress Evaluation Machine and he went back to Tennessee and conducted a PSE interview with Bud on his story. A copy of that interview and the preliminary analysis of the results are also enclosed with this letter for your review.


I have been very busy recently working to get Bud free from jail in Tennessee and Sara safe. This has been accomplished and the very latest status of this situation is conveyed by the letter Bud wrote DCI Stansfield Turner on 10-30-78. I am also enclosing for you to read, copies of a letter Bud wrote to Sara on 8-26-78, one he wrote me on 9-2-78 and copies of letters I have written to Sheriff Firman Stanley of Ellijay Georgia, District Attorney General Gary Gerbitz of Chattanooga, Tennessee and Assistant States Attorney Douglas Prior of Clearwater, Florida. The chips are down now and Bud is either going to get restitution from the government or this whole mess is about to blow wide open. As I said in my opening paragraph, I felt that you had a right to know some of the details of what has been happening since I last had contact regarding this situation.

I am totally disenchanted with our government and all branches thereof (including the one you work for). I believe that I have amassed sufficient evidence even without having a copy of the Journal to convince anyone as to what has been going on all these years including JFK, RFK and MLK. I no longer care who finds out the truths of this story as I have done and I am only sharing this with you so you can become prepared for any eventuality.
